Although IPM has been an established practice in the production of a range of ornamental crops for many years now, there is still a need for a clearer appreciation of the application of biological control agents within an IPM programme and a fuller understanding of the compatibility of agents with various plant protection products applied within a typical production programme. By Road - From Brighton via the A27

- Follow the signs for the A27 Portsmouth/Chichester, across the Westhampnett By Pass.
- At the first roundabout, Portfield, take the third exit signposted to Goodwood onto the Chichester By Pass.
- After 400 yards you come to a second roundabout; take the second exit.
- The hotel is located on the left hand side (see inset).

By Road - From Portsmouth via the A27

- Follow the signs for the A27 Chichester/Brighton.
- At the fifth roundabout, Portfield, take the second exit (straight over) to Goodwood.
- After 400 yards you come to a roundabout; take the second exit.
- The hotel is located on the left hand side (see inset).

By Bus - From Chichester Bus Station (opposite the railway station)

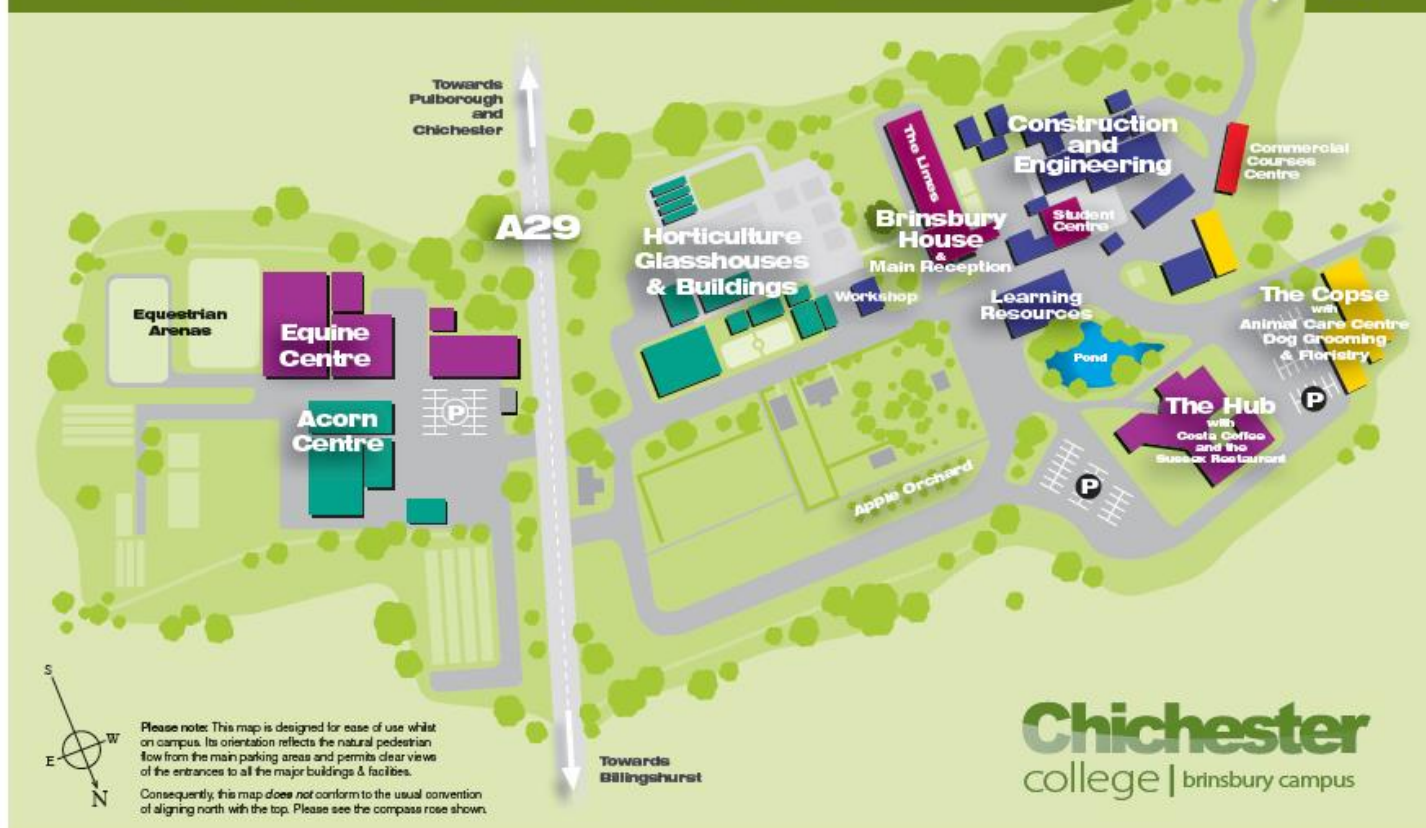
The number 55 bus to Tangmere will drop you around the corner from the hotel, opposite Homebase
